Learning to live and love in Jesus as we follow him together.




FIRST, WE'RE ALL ABOUT JESUS.


We saw what Jesus did, we turned from our ways, and we believed this good news – the Gospel of the Kingdom.

WHAT WE BELIEVE

(We actually try doing this stuff)

Jesus. We believe that Jesus is the Son of God—that we can follow him and be like him.

Holy Spirit. We believe in the person of the Holy Spirit and that he plays an active role in our everyday life.

The Bible. We believe the Bible is God's authoritative letter to us, teaching us to live a life worth living now and forever.

Surrender. Jesus gave up his life for us, therefore we should give up our life for him.

Spiritual Growth. Growing spiritually is a part of our church life. This means we take steps daily toward spiritual maturity.

Shepherding. Every family has a shepherd to give care and coaching.

Intimacy. We believe prayer and worship are the foundation of our intimacy and relationship with a Father who loves us.

Multiplication. We believe in spiritual reproduction. This looks like disciples making disciples that know how to make disciples.

Community. We believe in community and do not go it alone. Jesus insists on one another-ing. (Yes, that's a word now)

Serving. We believe in laying down our lives. This looks like serving our family, friends, and those in need.

Kingdom. We believe in a global commission and investing in Kingdom efforts around the world by praying, giving, and going.

FOLLOWING JESUS

We look at the Bible together to learn who Jesus is, what he did and why it matters. The Holy Spirit helps us walk out these things in our everyday life—at home, in the workplace, and every area of our lives.

Everything we do as we follow Jesus is designed to honor his Father, who adopted us into his family through the power of the Holy Spirit.

So we worship a 3-in-1 God – Father, Son and Spirit.

They created the church and so they run it together, using ordinary folks like us to get involved in extraordinary things like rescuing children, feeding the poor, healing people and restoring relationships. This is what we mean by living and loving in Jesus.

THE REAL MEANING OF CHURCH


Most people think the Church is the building. That's an accident of history and translation. When Jesus used the word he meant "people called out"—that is, people called out of normal life to follow Him in an extraordinary adventure.

SO, WE ARE THE CHURCH.

We are the people who have found the most important message in history and we love to share it. We are the people who have been given new life by God and who now carry his Holy Spirit in us wherever we go.

We believe we are all priests according to God. So we are learning to be priests in our families, workplaces and communities. We shepherd and take care of each family as they grow into this very important work. We also work with and invest in other churches—because there is only one church.





THE GATHERINGS

We have meetings on Sunday so that a variety of gifted people can lead us in worship, stories, and the study of God's Word. We also have similar age-appropriate time for our kids so they can connect with God in a language they can understand.

The rest of our meetings happen Monday-Saturday, most often in our homes.

We believe the core building block of following Jesus is in our families. We have families of all shapes and sizes, but we follow a common way of doing family—centered on Jesus. We also believe in small church gatherings throughout the week with smaller numbers of disciples gathering to go deeper, share life and keep each other sharp and well cared for.



OUR FOOTPRINT

We see our spiritual footprint at Mariemont Church mostly through our lifestyle and our generosity.

One of the ways we do this is to remember that we can store up treasures in heaven as Jesus commanded us to in Luke 12:33. We have coined the term "L-1233 account" as a way to help us remember that there is something eternal that goes beyond our typical "401K". At MCC, we desire to build what we call "global kingdom disciples"—folks who live for Jesus and his Kingdom worldwide.

Our missions program is reaching dozens of nations globally with the Good News of Jesus' love. This represents about 20% of our budget.

NIGERIA

In the past 7 years, believers in Jesus in the Dukawa tribe in Nigeria have grown from 1,000 to 10,000. We are involved in various stages of five more languages with significant potential.

STUDENTS

Our U.S.-based missionaries reach thousands of college students nationally.



PRE-SCHOOL

Our self-funding pre-school reaches 100 children for Jesus weekly, and the before and after school program extends to 30-40 children.

LOCAL COMMUNITY

We host dozens of community groups--including Scouts and AA that all point people to Jesus. Our Family Shop provides a bi-monthly used clothing store that serves dozens in our local community. The proceeds go to help women meet Christ in prisons and transition to healthy lives in society, and other community needs.

MULTIPLICATION

One of our missionaries is training believers and growing church planting movements that extend to thousands in several cities.

OUR CHURCH FAMILY


Every week we help over 120 families disciple their nearly 100 children and students.

30 new believers baptized (2014–2016)

Dozens more learned how to grow and walk in the Spirit, while 75 people have moved into deeper discipleship with Jesus by traveling to Israel in the past three years.

Our congregation regulars help give leadership to 20 local and national ministries.


We pray for and are deeply connected to other churches in our city.
